Metro Atlanta Relocation Council Members Pack 5,796 pounds of food for the Atlanta Community Food Bank.

Atlanta, GA – October 14 – Thirty five members from the Metro Atlanta Relocation Council ([MARC](#)) volunteered for a community service project that benefited 3,985 people by packing 5,796 pounds of food. The *Atlanta Community Food Bank* is a 25-year-old organization that has a mission “to fight hunger by engaging, educating and empowering our community”. The MARC membership is involved in several such community service projects each year. Collections were made at the September and November meetings for the *Atlanta Women’s Shelter*, and the December 9th meeting will benefit the *Toys for Tots*.
